

Data protection information on video surveillance

We use video surveillance on the property we use at **Mühlenstraße 7, 68169 Mannheim**. According to Articles 13 and 14 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), there are information obligations when collecting personal data. For this reason, we are providing you with the following information:

Type of data collected

Video surveillance records moving images, i.e. features that allow us to identify you. Car number plates may also be recorded in entrance areas.

Purpose of data processing

Video surveillance is used to enforce property rights, prevent criminal offences (in particular burglary and vandalism) and associated disruptions to operations, and to secure evidence in the event of criminal offences.

Legal basis for data processing

The legal basis for video surveillance is Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR, whereby our interests arise from the aforementioned purposes.

Recipients/transfer of data

Within our administration, those departments that need the currently stored video recordings to perform their tasks are given access to them. Data will only be transferred to third parties if a recording gives rise to serious suspicion that the stored data provides information that one or more persons have committed or attempted to commit a criminal offence against us. In this case, we will forward the data to the competent authorities (police, public prosecutor's office).

Data processing outside the European Union

Personal data is not processed outside the European Union in the context of video surveillance.

Storage period

Data from video surveillance is generally deleted after 9 days. In the event of absence or illness of the responsible personnel, video recordings may be kept for longer in individual cases. If there are indications that the videos contain information about potential criminal offences, we reserve the right to store the videos until the matter has been clarified.

Rights of data subjects

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR). If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR). If the legal requirements are met, you can request the deletion or restriction of processing and object to processing (Art. 17, 18 or 21 GDPR). If you have consented to data processing, you may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR). You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
